The 2016 U.S. Formula 5000 Revival Races will take place at the following venues:

- **July 14-17: Road America – The WeatherTech International Challenge with Brian Redman present by Hawk**
- **September 8-11: U.S. Vintage Grand Prix with SVRA at Watkins Glen**
- **September 30 - October 2: Charity Challenge at Sonoma Raceway with CSRG (Tentative)**
